Caring for sick cats and kittens, dogs and puppies and the odd ferret! These animals are usually suffering from various diseases and viruses.

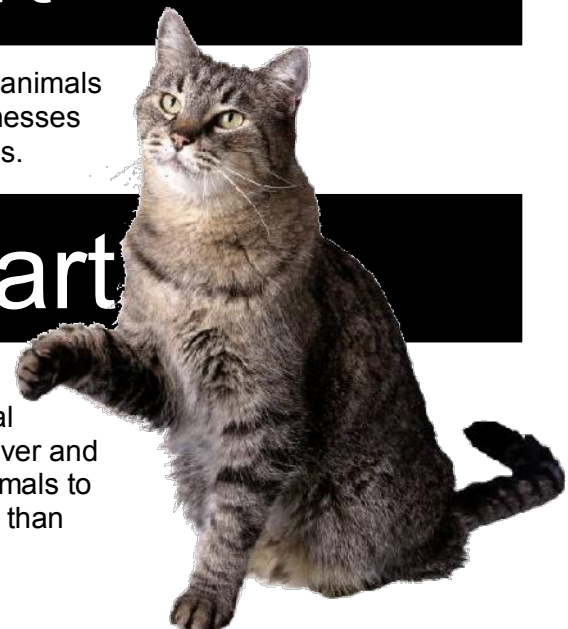
Places to work are any animal welfare organisations that you are passionate about and vet clinics throughout the country.
